



## TEAM LEADER – NON REVENUE WATER

**Purpose:** To minimize water loss through management and monitoring of the bulk meter, maintenance and repairing of burst pipes, investigating and monitoring of illegal connections

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Management of the bulk meter through capturing and processing of meter readings and acting on discrepancies thereof.
- Liaise with other Operations teams who are responsible for routine meter readings.
- Routine monitoring of district metered zone volumes and co-ordination of investigations and audits to ascertain the status of the isolating valves.
- Management of the district metered zone by conducting routine checks on reservoir levels using the SCADA system
- Reporting of instrument problems to the relevant department for maintenance or calibration
- Management of planned and unplanned data logging activities, including programming, site deployment, data downloads, retrieval of data loggers and management of logged data files
- Management and assistance with Rural Water Demand and Leakage benchmarking exercises
- Manage Asset Management activities, including maintaining underground asset records, capturing of new assets information and site investigations into determining information for low confidence asset knowledge areas
- Assist the Non Revenue Water Manager with hydraulic modeling tasks and model calibration activities
- Manage meter testing activities

- Code 08 Drivers' license

- One to two years' relevant experience working in a similar environment.
